

TEACHERS-ORIENTED TRAINING AND WORKSHOPS' CYCLE

In 2020, non-governmental organization "Diversity Development Group" – international project "InterCap" partner in Lithuania – successfully proceeded with the cycle of teachers-oriented educational events and organised a total of four training sessions and six accompanying "second-phase" workshops, designed to address topics of migration, security, sustainable development, and global education.

During the trainings and workshops held, inclusive teaching methods that encourage pupils and students to discuss global problems and raise contraversial questions with regard to migration, security and sustainable development, were introduced.

One-day or two-day long training sessions were delivered by lector Jogaila Vaitekaitis. Vytautas Magnus University trainers and members of the Anna Lindh Foundation actively joined discussions, tried out the recommended methodology, and were in detail introduced to an e-learning platform.










WEBINARS HELD BY SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT EXPERTS
