

### WHAT IS PITCH?

PITCH is a three-year EU-funded project, launched on January 1, 2022. PITCH stands for 'a model for gender-sensitive integration strategies based on Personalised, participaTory, loCal, and multistakeHolder approaches.' PITCH comprises 13 partners, including 5 municipalities, 7 local research/civil organisations and a wide network of Baltic Sea Region cities. Throughout its lifetime, PITCH involved foreign-born women, social operators, policy-makers, private, civil and public entities working in the field of integration, as well as the wider public.

PITCH aims to establish a common European ground to support the design and implementation of local integration strategies based on a gender-sensitive, personalised, localised, participatory, and multi-stakeholder approach. The project does so by co-designing the PITCH Model, that was adjusted into 7 local strategies.

The strategies were piloted, directly engaging **229** foreign-born women in Italy, Greece, Slovenia, Spain, Cyprus, Lithuania and Sweden.

#### **NEIGHBOURHOOD MAPS**

To facilitate the process of integration in the host communities, PITCH has developed interactive maps that visualise important services which can support the accessibility and knowledge of foreign-born women about local entities in order to learn more about local opportunities on employment, education, civil rights awareness and social interaction.

#### DEVELOPMENT OF LOCAL INTEGRATION STRATEGIES FOR FOREIGN-BORN WOMEN

Based on the **PITCH Model** developed, seven local integration strategies were developed and pilot tested, benefitting a total of 229 foreign-born women between 2023-24. ### MAINSTREAMING THE PITCH MODEL

The partnership organised local panel discussions, national and regional webinars, as well as capacity building trainings to local authorities and other actors' staff with the aim to equip them with the knowledge and skills to sustain the local integration strategies implemented, as well as utilise the PITCH Model to design and develop local integration programmes or initiatives.

#### PITCH INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE IN BRUSSELS

Hosted in Brussels, Belgium, on December 5, 2024, the conference brought together a diverse audience of actors from local and EU institutions. The conference demonstrated the three-year work of the partnership and gave the floor to PITCH graduates, trainers and mediators, as well as local authorities involved in the piloting of the strategies to share their experience and their next steps towards sustaining and mainstreaming the local integration strategies. The aim of the conference was to share the findings with policymakers in Brussels and encourage other actors to adopt the PITCH Model and recommendations as outlined in the PITCH White Paper.

I've always been hesitant to go to activities because I used to go alone. Now, I just post it on WhatsApp and always have someone from PITCH to go with.






















I learn basic Greek to communicate with my neighbour. I meet new people from the community, I know more about taxes, civil rights etc. I feel so happy to take part in this programme.



We learned Greek and now we are talking to our neighbours, and in the supermarket in Greek. It is also helping us to understand more about our children's school activities and support with their homework.




















I benefited a lot from all the activities that I participated. They helped me understand my rights and learn information and details that I didn't know even though I live in Cyprus for more than ten years.
